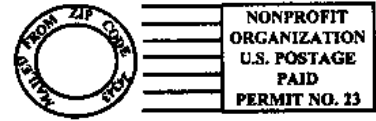

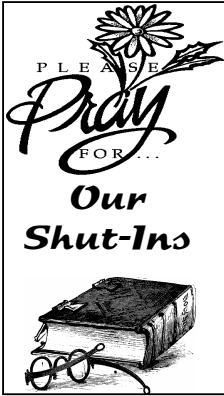

Also, on 4th of July we plan to have a table of baked foods, **Early morning:** sausage and ham biscuits and coffee.

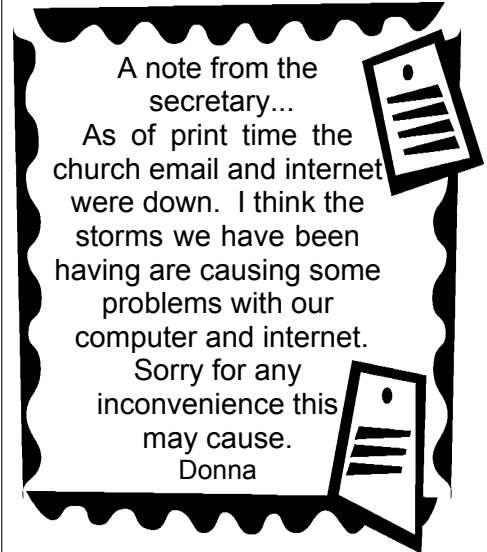
For lunch: hot dogs and cold drinks will be prepared.

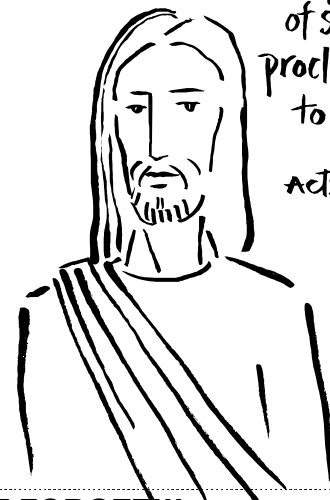


A note from the secretary...
