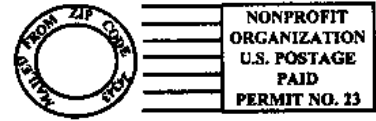

 the task. As the conversation goes on Moses asks God,

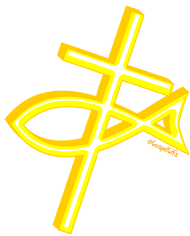
"What's your name anyway?"

Through all of time and eternity -

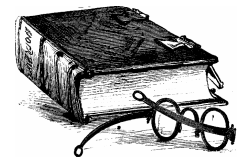
"God Is."
